



7 STEPS ON DOCUMENTING ICE ENCOUNTERS

1

Stay at least an arm's length away from an officer as you film. Don't interfere. If they tell you to back up, film your feet doing so.

2

If possible, have a secondary observer filming you while you film the scene. This provides a full picture of the encounter.

3

Film horizontally to capture as much as you can of what's happening. Focus primarily on the officers and what they are doing or saying.

4

Narrate everything you are seeing with as much detail as possible. (ex. amount of officers, whether wearing a mask or not, types of vehicles, and location/landmarks)

5

DO NOT share your video on social media. Please be respectful of the privacy of the individual being detained.

6

DO NOT edit or alter your video in any way. The footage may be used in court proceedings.
